

# BINGO HOUSE RULES

1. You must be 18 to play bingo. ID is required upon request.
2. It is the player's responsibility to yell "Bingo" loud enough to notify the Caller and to stop the game. --NO EXCEPTIONS-- Continue shouting "Bingo" until the caller has acknowledged that the game has stopped. The caller will turn on the flashing lights when he/she has heard a bingo. If the lights are not flashing, continue shouting "Bingo" until they begin to flash, and the caller has acknowledged the game has stopped.
3. If you are unable to shout loud enough to stop the game, be sure to sit close enough to the caller to get his/her attention.
4. We do not pay "Sleepers". You must bingo on the last number called. The last number is valid until the letter of the next ball is called.
5. Floorworkers are here to serve you and answer your questions.
6. Flash boards and monitors are for convenience only. The actual ball drawn and shown is official. Please do not shout "Bingo" until your winning number has been called.
7. Callers are human and do make mistakes. In the event of an error by the caller, the actual number drawn is the only valid number. State law prohibits us from making any payouts which are not the result of a valid bingo.
8. Please hold your cards until a bingo is verified.
9. Multiple winners split the prize, which will be rounded down to the nearest dollar.
10. Although we make every effort to avoid having duplicate cards on the floor, this may occur. Duplicate winners will split prizes.
11. ID and signature are required on prize receipts for all Bingo prizes of \$100 or more and on any prize in which a specific dollar amount can not be predetermined before the start of the game.
12. The "Original" set of cards for break-open Bonanza Bingo will be blue, "trade- ins" will be any color except blue. Duplicate faces may occur during the break-open Bonanza game.
13. The cost of the break-open Bonanza card is \$1.00 for an "original" card and .25¢ each for a "trade-in" card sold in quantities of two only with trade-in.
14. Break-open Bonanza cards must contain the specific validation for the session to be a valid winning card.
15. A customer must purchase and play a Regular Session package or Intermission package to play specials.
16. A customer must be playing his/her own bingo package or specials to be seated at a bingo table.
17. Packages and special game cards shall not be separated or cut.
18. All bingo cards in play must be furnished by the organization conducting bingo and may not be taken out of the building. (With the exception of braille cards.)
19. Coupons must be redeemed at the time of purchase. Only one coupon may be used per package. Coupons are not valid on discounted packages.
20. Special discount prices are not valid on Intermission packages.
21. No refunds will be given on unused packages or specials.
22. Carousel Bingo staff, gaming management, and employees may not play bingo at this establishment.
23. Management reserves the right to make changes in programs and prices without notice.
24. Weather policy - In the event that Carousel Bingo would close for inclement weather or any other unforeseen event, progressive jackpots will carryover to the next regularly scheduled occasion for that organization. In the unlikely event that we need to close an occasion already in progress due to weather or other unforeseen event, unfortunately no cash refunds will be made.
25. In an effort to assure the accuracy of the games played in this facility and in compliance with the rules of play, electronic monitoring equipment is used. The equipment is intended to record the activities of the caller. Both visual and oral communications are being monitored at all times. In this process the patrons of this facility also may have their oral discussions recorded. The recording devices are located near the caller's stand. By entering these premises for the purposes of participating in the activities conducted herein, you are consenting to the recording of your visual image and to the recording of your oral communications.

# PULLTAB HOUSE RULES

1. You must be 18 to play pulltabs. ID is required upon request.
2. There is no purchase limit on a low jar.

3. Please open and redeem winning tickets immediately. Winning tickets that leave the Hall are not valid and will not be paid.
4. We do not knowingly play dead jars -- but due to customers holding their winners, factory defects, and human error, we cannot guarantee a winner in any jar.
5. ID and signature are required on prize receipts for all winning pulltabs of \$50.00 or more.
6. If you are in the Hall only to play pulltabs, please do not open them in the jar bar area. Please open pulltabs at the designated pulltab table.
7. By State law, Jar Dealers are not allowed to describe the condition of the game. Please do not ask for inside information. Providing or receiving inside information is against the law. A person who violates this is guilty of a gross misdemeanor.
8. Carousel Bingo staff, gaming management, and employees may not play pulltabs at this establishment.

## GENERAL RULES

1. In compliance with State law, no checks or purchases on credit are allowed. Travelers' checks and money orders are acceptable. Lawful gambling must be on a cash basis in advance of play.
2. No one under 18 will be admitted. ID required upon request.
3. Management is not responsible for personal belongings lost, stolen, or damaged. Please contact the Session Supervisor for items lost or found.
4. No alcoholic beverages are allowed.
5. No outside food or beverages are allowed.
6. Management reserves the right to refuse service to anyone. Anyone disturbing others with abusive language or conduct will be required to leave and will be refused service in the future.
7. Federal law requires us to withhold 28% of any sweepstakes winnings of more than \$5,000.00. However, a correct social security number must be given and a W-2G form must be filled out and signed for all sweepstakes winnings of more than \$600.00 (No W-2G, No signature, No cash). Federal law also requires us to withhold 31% of all bingo winnings of over \$1,200.00 if a winner fails to furnish a correct social security number. In addition, a W-2G form must be signed for all bingo winnings of more than \$1,200.00 (No W-2G, No Signature No Cash).
8. Thank you, but our employees are not allowed to accept tips.
9. Please refer any problems to the Gambling Manager or gambling manager designee whose decision is final.
10. Illegal gambling is prohibited on these premises.
